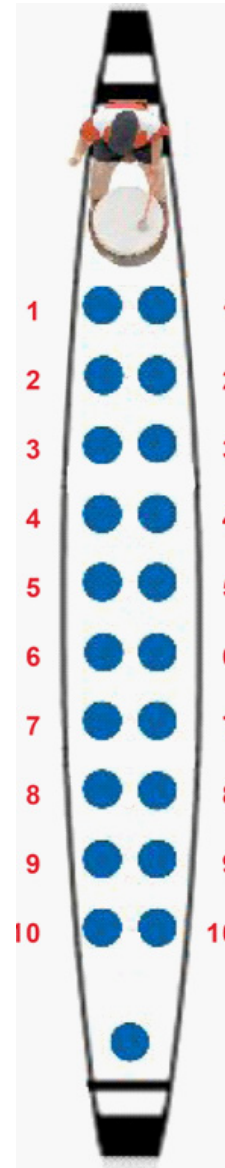

## TEAM INFORMATION

- One drummer to motivate the team and keep the paddlers in sync
- One steersperson to guide the team down the race course
- 20 paddlers in 2 rows of 10 per boat
- Each team will race in 3 heats throughout the day, the first heat for a qualifying time; the second heat is a semi-final, and the final heat for a championship final.
- The race course distance is approximately 300 meters
- Medals are awarded for the top 3 teams in each division; gold, silver and bronze

The Athletes' Village is located adjacent to VIP reception tent. This is the rest area for racing teams.

The marshaling area is where teams line up in order to be assigned and loaded on a boat, for their specific race time on the race schedule. Teams will be called to marshaling 20 minutes before the race start time. The team captain is responsible for getting their team to the marshaling area 20 minutes prior to your assigned race time.
